

Programs

The library sponsors free programs for adults and children. These include readings and book signings, informational and history programs, a film series, music entertainment, children's story hours, arts and crafts programs, and an annual children's summer reading club. If there is no waiting list, most items can be renewed **once** in person, online, or by phone (with the exception of items that are more than 14 overdue). DVDs and reserved materials may not be renewed.

Most items may be returned at any OSL library. All South Kingstown locations have an available book drop to return materials.

Overdue Fines/Fees

Adult or Juvenile materials: 10¢ per day, per item

Adult maximum: \$6 per item

Juvenile maximum: \$3 per item

Magazine maximum: \$3 per item

DVDs/Videos: \$2 per day, per item

DVDs/Video maximum \$10 per item

Museum Passes: \$5 per day, maximum \$10

ILL: \$3 per postage – non-renewable

Damaged Audio/Visual materials: \$5 processing fee

Replacement library cards: \$1.00

Overdue fines must be under \$5.00 in order to check out materials or renew an expired Ocean State Libraries card

*Patrons are required to pay the full replacement cost of any damaged or lost materials checked out on the Ocean State Library card. In-kind replacements are not accepted

Services for Card holders

Holds: You may reserve books or other items and pick them up at any OSL library you choose.

Interlibrary Loan: If South Kingstown or other OSL libraries do not have the items you need, Reference Services staff can request items through interlibrary loan. Allow at least a week.

Ocean State Libraries

The South Kingstown Public Library System is part of a shared network of more than 50 Rhode Island libraries called Ocean State Libraries (OSL). Your OSL library card allows you to borrow items from any library in this network. Visit www.oslri.org to search for items, find a list of member libraries, and see what's new.

The Collection

The South Kingstown Public Library collection includes 75,750 books; e-books, audio books; large print books; reference books, online resources; magazines and newspapers; videos, DVDs, and music CDs.

Library Cards

A library card must be presented for any library transaction. Cards are issued free at any of the library's circulation desks. To obtain a library card, you must present a photo ID. South Kingstown cardholders have borrowing privileges at all OSL member libraries. Any resident of Rhode Island may use South Kingstown Public Library's resources. For out-of-state residents, fees may apply; ask at the circulation desk.

Board of Trustees: Seven trustees are appointed by the Town Council and meet monthly. They make policy decisions and oversee library administration. **Library Board:** Betty J.
